



## **DOMESTIC TOURISM EXPENDITURE AND MULTIPLE INDICATORS JANUARY 2020 -DECEMBER 2020**

The National Statistical Office (NSO) (erstwhile NSSO) has been in the service of the nation since 1950. It has been developing a strong database on various Socio-Economic parameters through its countrywide sample surveys, which have helped the Central as well as State Governments in development planning and policy formulations. The Socio-Economic Surveys conducted by NSO are in the form of rounds, each round being normally of one-year duration.

### **UTILITY OF NSS DATA**

The data collected by NSSO plays major role in development of nation with the help of planning, research, formulation and implementation of welfare policies which leads to betterment and welfare of the society by providing them with various schemes and programmes to upgrade their standard of life.

### **CURRENT SURVEY**

The National Statistical Office (NSO) and the Directorates of Economics and Statistics of various States are collecting data on domestic tourism expenditure and multiple indicators its 78<sup>th</sup> Round of survey from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2020 to 31<sup>st</sup> December 2020. The survey will collect detailed information on household expenditure on tourism along with some information on household characteristics and trip characteristics in relation to domestic overnight trips, required for preparation of Tourism Satellite Account (TSA). In addition, some important information on trips and expenditure shall also be collected in connection with domestic same-day trips and special domestic trips.

### **COLLECTION OF INFORMATION**

Well-qualified and trained officers of NSSO collect information using schedules or hand-held devices like tablets that are specially designed for such surveys. These officers visit villages and towns, selected on a scientifically designed technique; list the houses and households, and; select a specified number of households to collect the detailed information by interviewing the head of household or a responsible and knowledgeable person of the household. State Governments also, on matching basis, collect information using the same methodology and schedules.

**Information collected pertaining to an individual or family in the survey is kept confidential and is not revealed to anybody, including other Government Departments.**

### **SOLICITING COOPERATION OF RESPONDENTS**

The success of these surveys depends to a great extent on the quality of the response from public in providing correct information. Officers of NSO may be approaching you for necessary information. Without your cooperation and necessary help, it will not be possible to get required reliable data. The Government, therefore, appeals to you to extend your kind cooperation to our officers approaching you for this survey and to spare some of your valuable time to provide them correct and complete information.
